

# Explaining the NC Internet Tax: Currently in North Carolina:

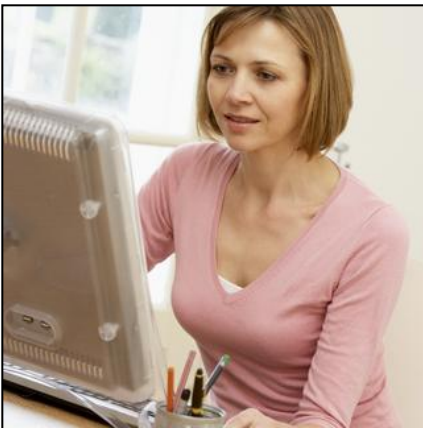


Cindy Jones visits a website selling children’s books. While there she makes a purchase.

**She pays no sales tax.**

**Section 27C.2** in the proposed NC budget says that many online companies **must charge sales tax** for online purchases made by North Carolina residents.

If **Section 27C.2** is included in the budget:
